Like Father, like Son: Honor Him

Long ago and at different times, God sent messages through prophets. In the Old Testament books, there are many prophets that God sent to speak to His people. Today’s lesson tells us that Jesus, God’s Son, spoke to the people for God. Jesus is the mirror image of God. When we obey Jesus, we obey God.

After Jesus died for all the sins of the world, He went to sit beside God in heaven. Has God ever said to any of the angels, “You are my Son?” or “I will be his Father?” No. When Jesus came into the world, God said, “Let all God’s angels worship him.” What does God say about angels? They are messengers, but they are not greater than the Son. God says that the Son’s throne will last forever and ever. We can worship Jesus because He gave His life for our sins. Jesus is superior to the angels.

We should not worship angels. We should worship Jesus Christ, who is the only Son of God; Jesus is unique. Jesus has the highest place of worship. Because we believe that Jesus is the Son of God, one day we will live with Him in heaven.
