
Wake-up Call




Wake-up Call

NEW SHIPPING INFO

We normally ship UPS ground because it is efficient, cost-effective, and insured. UPS requires a street address because they will not deliver to a post office box. When you place your order, you will be able to request overnight or second-day shipping. As with all shipments, please check your order as soon as it arrives. In the unlikely event that you have problems, please note your invoice number and as much other information as possible to increase our ability to help you before you call us.

STANDING ORDERS

As an added convenience, SSPB offers our convenient, yearly (annual) shipping and billing options for quarterly curriculum. Simply indicate "Standing Order Curriculum Shipment Program," complete the enclosed order form, and send payment in full for the year. Following your initial order, we will begin sending your predetermined quantities of curriculum. Standing orders are processed and shipped to arrive approximately three (3) weeks prior to the beginning of the next quarter.

AUTOMATIC ORDERS

SSPB also provides an automatic shipping and billing option for quarterly Sunday school curriculum. To begin, you need an approved credit application on file. You may also call Customer Service at 1-800-359-9398 and your sales representative will assist you in opening an account and placing your initial order. Following your initial order, we will begin sending your predetermined quantities of curriculum.
