Doing What Is Just!

(Matthew 21:1-2, 6-8, 12-17)

Jesus and His disciples were almost to Jerusalem. Jesus told two disciples to get a donkey and its baby for Him. The disciples did what Jesus said. Then Jesus rode into Jerusalem on the donkey. When He did this, the people placed palm leaves and clothes on the ground.

Later, Jesus went into the Temple. People were buying and selling things there. Jesus was not happy about this. He knocked over their tables. The Temple was supposed to be a house of prayer.

Jesus also healed sick people. The children praised God for Jesus! The leaders were not happy about any of it. But Jesus did what was right.

In today's lesson, your child heard that Jesus entered the Temple where people were buying and selling things. Jesus could not sit still and let sin go unchecked.
