



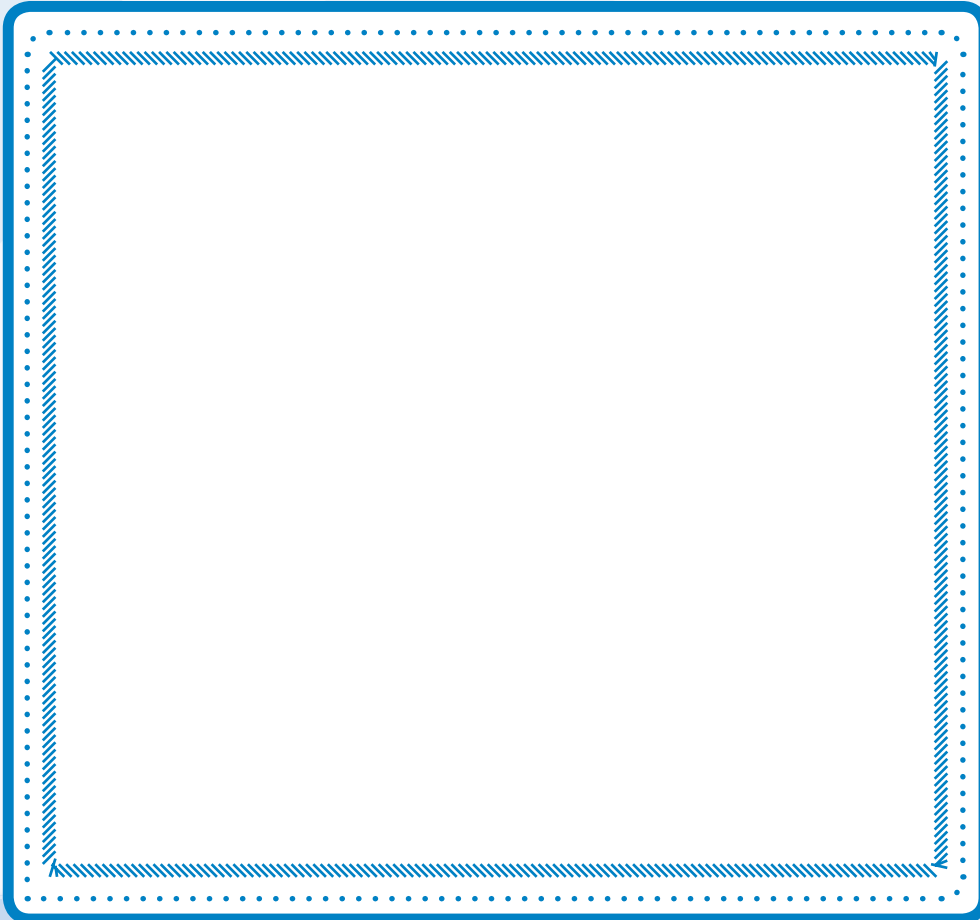
Lesson Scripture: Jeremiah 22:1-10

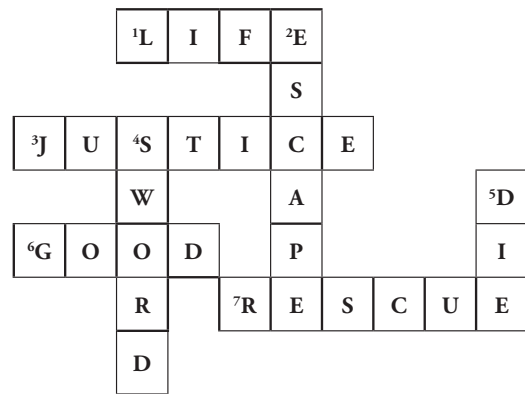

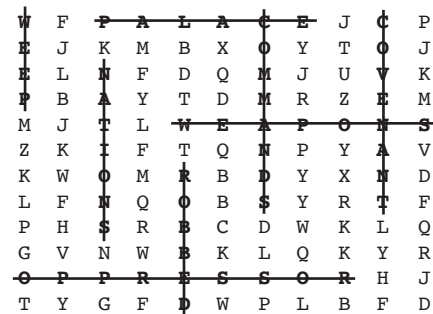
