Changing Our Ways

(Jeremiah 22:1-10)

In today's Bible verses, God gave Jeremiah a message for the king of Judah. Jeremiah told the king and all the people that God would give them one more chance to do right. They should be kind to strangers and children with no parents. They should be fair to widows. *Widows* are women whose husbands have died. They should protect innocent people.

If the people did these good things, then they would be blessed. But if they did not, then they would be attacked and the land of Judah would be destroyed.

God calls us to be kind and loving too.
