



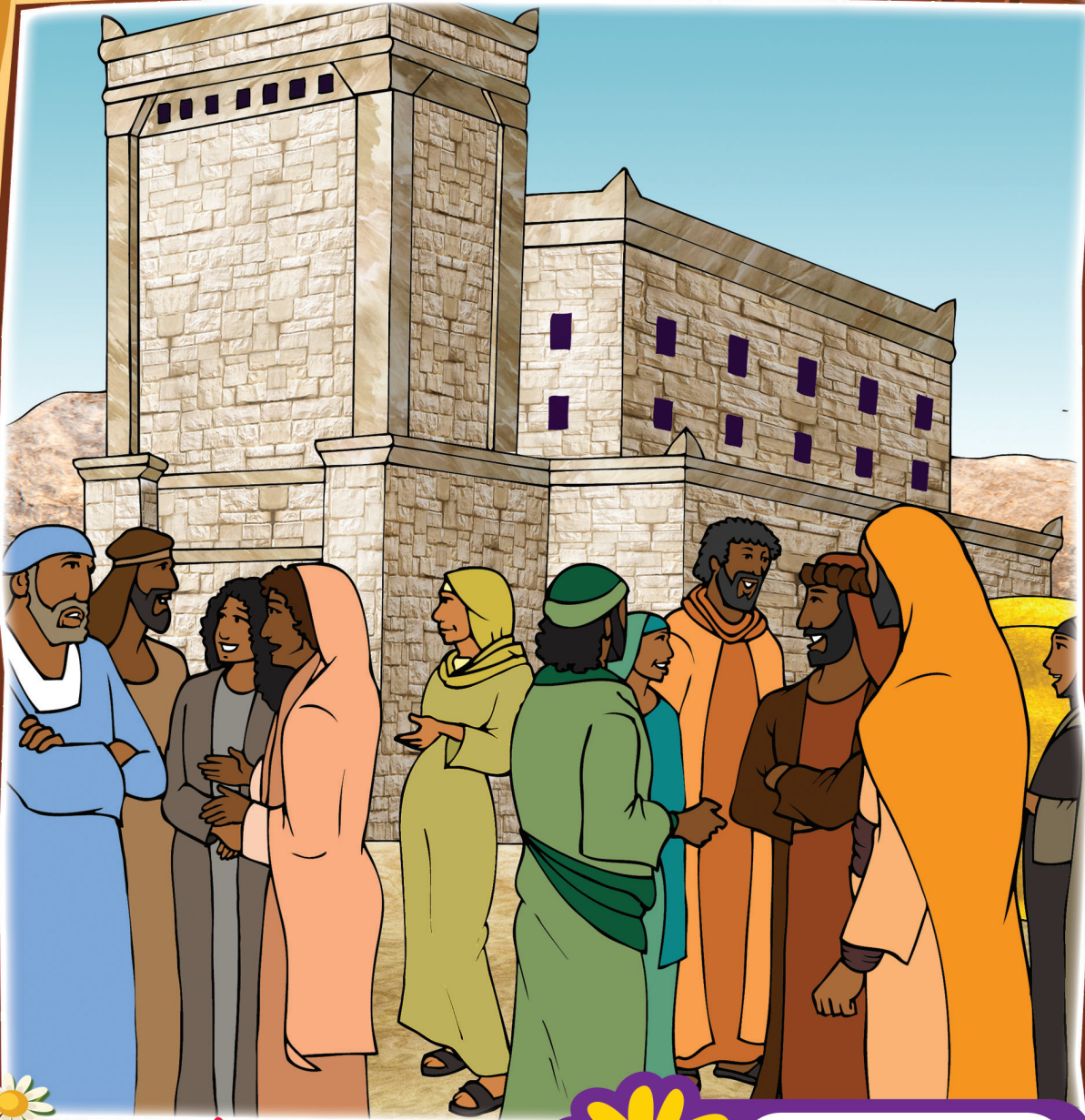

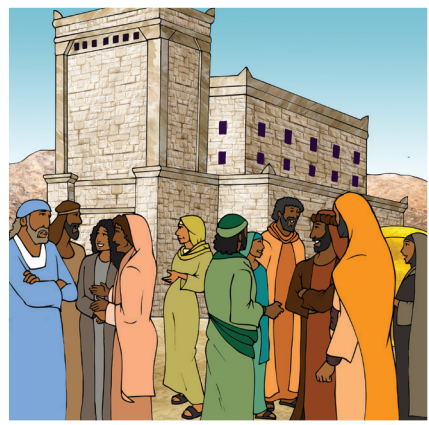
Lesson Scripture:

(Zechariah 8:1-8, 11-17)
