Key Verse(s):

Questions to Consider:

- 1. What does it mean to be in the world, but not of the world?
- 2. How does a follower of Christ become **sanctified**?
- 3. What is the believer's **purpose** in the world today

Lesson Aims:

As a result of experiencing this lesson, you should be able to do these things:

- Explore Jesus' intercessory prayer for His disciples.
- Long for Jesus' prayer to be answered more fully in your lives and in the church.
- Pray for others and work for unity in the body of Christ.

Lesson Context:

This week's lesson takes place during what is referred to as "the upper room discourse." Jesus knew His time was near to return to the father. His earthly ministry was coming to an end. These were the last days of His life among His disciples on earth

► Lesson Outlines/Key Points:

I. Set Apart to Intercede (John 17:14-16)

Key Point 1: Jesus knows that the world has rejected and hated Him and therefore the same attitude and hatred will be heralded at His disciples.

	Key Point 2: Jesus prays for the protection of His disciples.
II.	Sanctified to Intercede (John 17:17-21) Key Point 1: Jesus didn't ask God to take believers out of the world but instead to use them in the world.
	Key Point 2: Jesus then further extends the covering of His prayer to all of those who are to come that will believe in Jesus based on the message delivered by the disciples.
III.	Shining to Intercede (John 17:22-24) Key Point 1: Jesus' concern is that His followers live lives that glorify God - The glorious unity of being one.
	Key Point 2: The essence of God's equipping us is not for us to shine amongst each other but to shine throughout the world.
