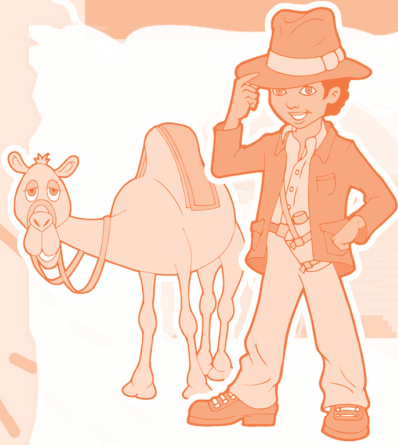




Lesson Scripture: Joshua 11:16-23

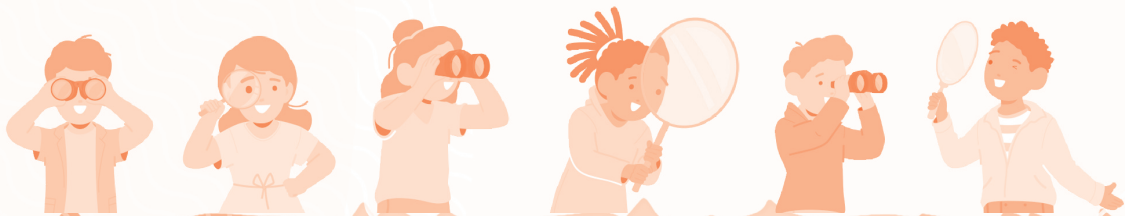


Fix That Phrase!

6. He gave it as an inheritance to their Israel according to tribal divisions.

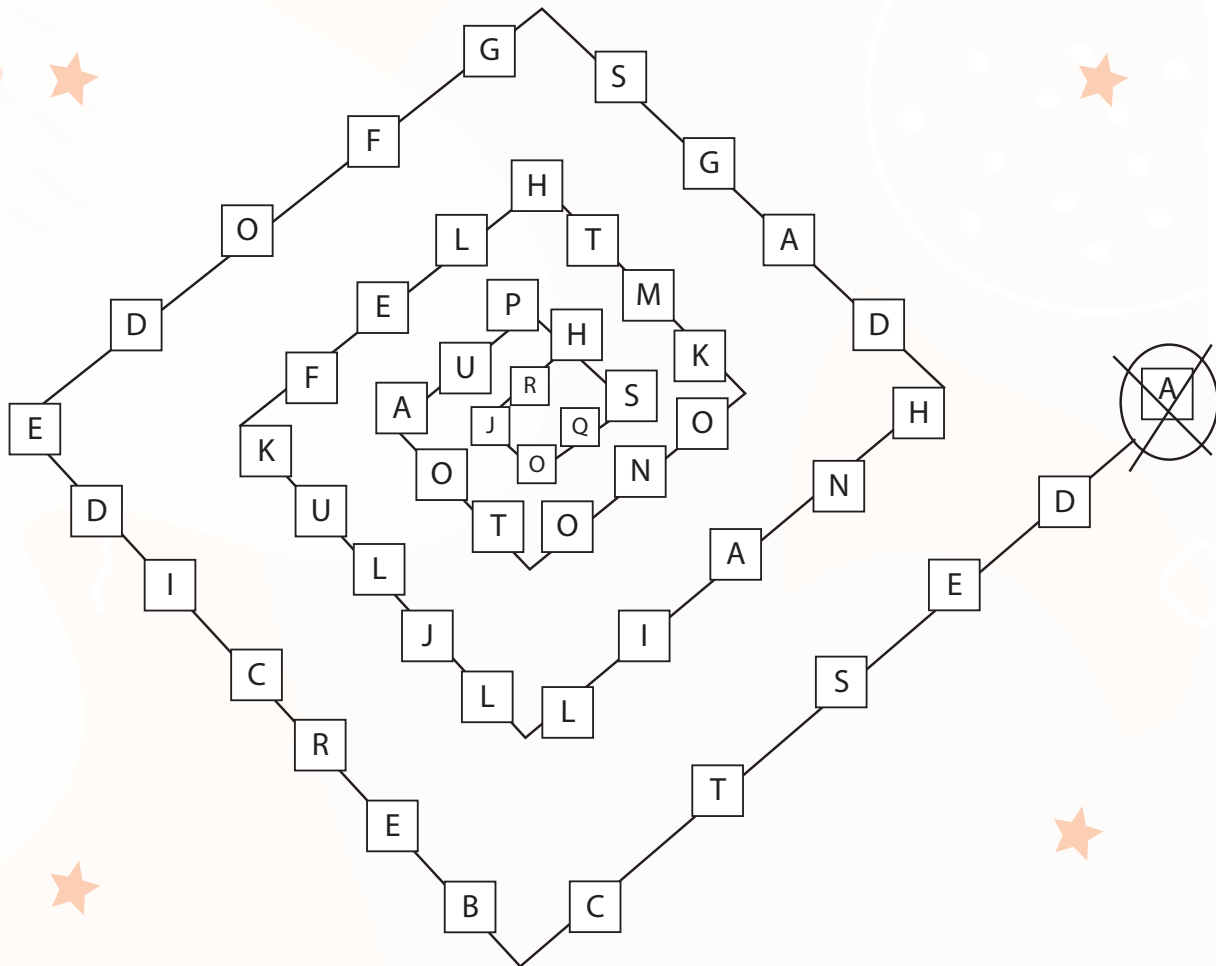

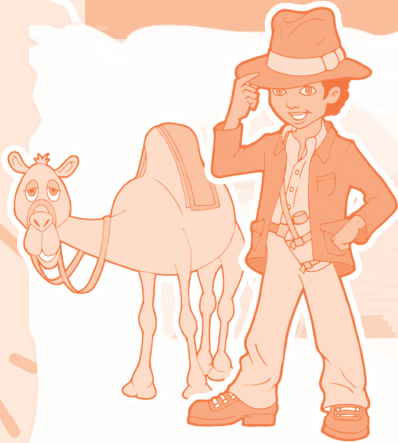
Make It Appear!

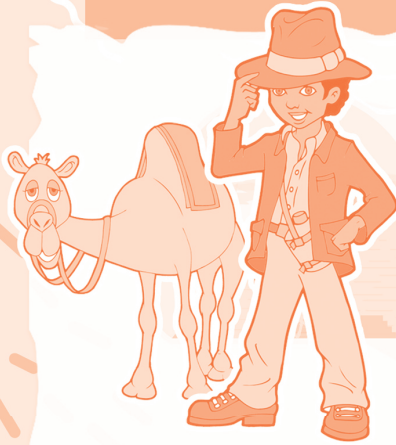

Plug It In

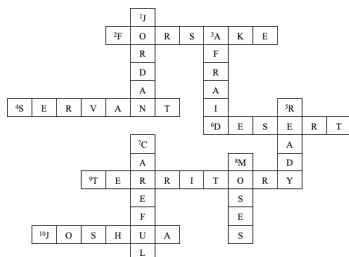
